TOURNAMENT TYPE: NRA precision pistol Regional 2700 match with Distinguished Revolver CMP Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Excellence-in-Competition (EIC) matches.

<u>TIME</u>: Start at 9:00 a.m. Competitors should be on the line by 8:45 a.m. Registration opens at 7:30am. Check-in no later than 30 minutes prior to the start time.

RULES: NRA Pistol Rules will govern the Regional Pistol Championship and Revolver Match. CMP Rules govern the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire EIC Matches. Competitors are responsible for knowledge, familiarity and compliance of rules, and this match program. Ear, eye protection, and empty chamber indicators are mandatory.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual. NRA membership encouraged but not required.

SQUADDING: Check-in 7:30 a.m. to register. Advise us of changes to your registration information. Competitors should check materials to fill in their name, NRA classification, and target number on all scorecards. Competitors, who fail to present themselves at the proper firing points when the preparation period begins, may lose their right to compete in the event.

FACILITIES: 25 points with 50 yard stationary and 25 yard turning targets. B6 & B8 targets.

ENTRIES: Entries for individual matches will be limited to 25 competitors on one relay.

ENTRY FEES to be paid by cash, check, and/or current NRA award points.

<u>CHALLENGE FEE</u>: \$2.00 for each challenge. Returned if jury decides in favor of the competitor.

SOUVENIR AWARD: Each competitor will receive a souvenir pin furnished by the NRA.

CLASSES & CATEGORIES: The NRA Classification System will be used in all matches. Classes are High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman. Classes and categories may be combined except that no classes will be combined with High Master class. Unclassified shooters may be placed in a separate unclassified class; or, they may compete in Master class.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES: Grand Senior, Senior, Woman, and Junior. No cash award.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Match entries should be received no later than June 3rd.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted until range capacity is filled.

SCORING & REPAIRING TARGETS: Competitors to score each other down range after each 10shot string and are responsible for replacing/repairing targets then turning in completed signed scorecards at the end of each match fired. Competitors may use scoring overlays and must provide their own stapler, staples, and repair tape or pasters. Range officials use scoring plugs.

<u>NRA AWARDS</u>: NRA to provide Gold, Silver, and Bronze Tone Regional Medallions for the top three highest scores in the Grand Aggregate (Match 16). **Note:** For competitors shooting .22 caliber only across the course, the only the score used will be the .22 Caliber Aggregate (Match 5) to derive the Grand Aggregate score for top shooter awards.

DCPA AWARDS: 50% Cash awards provided minus registration fees and after match expenses. Open Winner cash award will be provided to the top competitor in each of the individual fired aggregate matches. Class & Category Place cash awards will be provided in each individual fired match and aggregate for every four competitors. Open Winners are not eligible for Class & Category Place awards in the same match. Highest class competes for Open awards only. **Note:** For competitors shooting .22 caliber only across the course, the only the score used will be the .22 Caliber Aggregate (Match 5) for derive the Grand Aggregate score for top shooter awards.

MATCH RESULTS: Preliminary results posted after match scores have been entered. Final Match Results may be emailed to competitors who provide an email address, Paper copies may be mailed to competitors who provide a self-addressed envelope.

FOOD: Donuts, Coffee & Water available. Breaks after .22 and Center Fire matches.

LEG MATCHES: AFTER the 2700 Pistol Regional. .22 Rimfire Pistol fired first followed by Service Pistol & Revolver Matches to be fired concurrently. Competitors must provide their own ammunition and firearms that may be shared. Firing will be the National Match Course.

EIC Service Pistol and .22 Caliber Rimfire Matches of Civilian Marksmanship Program

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants.
<u>Time & Date:</u> The afternoon of June 5^h AFTER Regional 2700 match.
<u>Match Fee:</u> \$15.00 per competitor for each or \$30.00 for both. Cash only.
<u>Course of Fire:</u> 30 round National Match Course of Fire. B6 & B8 targets
<u>Firearm:</u> "Service Pistol" and .22 Caliber Rimfire as defined in the Current CMP Rule book
<u>Equipment:</u> Competitor equipment and ammunition in accordance with CMP rules.
<u>Ammunition:</u> Any safe .45ACP or 9mm hardball ammunition in compliance with rules.
<u>Entries:</u> Non-distinguished shooters get priority. May not be fired for practice.
<u>Awards:</u> All awards and points will be issued by the CMP.
<u>Rules:</u> Current edition of the CMP Rulebook. CMP Rules will govern EIC Pistol Matches.

Eligibility: Only individuals who are eligible for NRA Pistol Competition pursuant to NRA Pistol rules shall be eligible to compete in this program. You <u>MUST compete in Regional Match</u> to be eligible to compete in this Distinguished Revolver Match.

<u>Time & Date:</u> The afternoon of June 5, 2016 **AFTER** Regional 2700 match. B6 & B8 targets, <u>**Awards:**</u> The NRA to provide badges and points in accordance to their established guidelines. <u>**Course of Fire:**</u> National Match Course will be used for all competitions under this program. <u>**Ammunition:**</u> Any Safe .38 caliber ammunition using the 158 grain round nose or semiwadcutter bullet only provided by competitors.
