The air pistol must be of .177 caliber and may use air or compressed, non-flammable gas such as CO ₂ for propellant.	40 shots (plus sighters) at 10 meters. 75 minutes for 40 shots with unlimited sighters. (15 minutes for sighters)	B40/4 3 shots per 4 bull target (Time limit is max. of 18 minutes to shoot 12 shots.)

Category: There are three categories of competitors and are defined by the shooting position used by the competitor. They are: *Basic Supported*, *Standing Supported* and *International (One-Handed) Standing*.

Basic Supported Maximum Age: 10. Minimum Age: None.

Athlete may be seated or standing, 1 or 2 hands on the grip. The grip and hands may be rested on a firm support or a counterbalanced “sling” stand (T Stand), which DCPA will have available. If the T stand is used, the support point may be anywhere between elbow(s) and grip. The competitor’s shooting arm should be fully extended, with the sights at eye level. The non-firing hand may provide support for the firing hand or the butt of the pistol. The shooter may rest any part of either or both hands and the butt of the pistol on the supporting material.

Standing Supported Maximum Age: 14 Minimum Age: None.

Athlete is standing, 1 hand on the grip. T Stand provides counterbalance support between elbow and grip. The competitor’s shooting arm must be fully extended, with the sights at eye level. DCPA will have a T stand available.

International (One-Handed) Standing Maximum Age: 20 Minimum Age: 13.

International rules apply. Unsupported standing with One hand on the grip.

Awards: Medals will be provided. An open winner in each event will be awarded. A 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc will be awarded as appropriate for every 3 shooters in an event thereafter.

Eligibility: Any person may compete in this program until 31 December of the year in which his or her 20th birthday occurs. There is no minimum age limit. For the purposes of these Rules, a competitor’s age for the entire year is considered to be the age that competitor will attain on or before 31 December of the year.

General: NRA Certified Instructor will be present. DCPA will exclude anyone not conducting himself or herself in a proper manner. DCPA has a small quantity of match quality air pistols available to competitors. Anyone wishing to use DCPA equipment must pre-register indicating same. Parents of Junior competitors who have their own equipment may elect to use their own equipment. Air pistols and pellets must conform to USA Shooting Rules and Specifications.

Location: From I-84 use Exit #13, US Route 9 North. Proceed 6 miles. Turn right onto New Hackensack Road (County Route 104). Go 2 miles. Turn right onto St. Nicolas Road. Go approximately one mile. DCPA is located on the left. Range phone number is (845) 297-4481 if you need help finding us.

DCPA INTRODUCING NEW JUNIOR SHOOT - PPP



Do you want to get your young shooter in a more competitive shoot? The Progressive-Position Pistol (PPP) program introduces young pistol shooters to competitive pistol target shooting and gives them a natural progression into the Junior Olympic pistol program. NRA and USA Shooting are jointly supporting and promoting the Progressive-Position Pistol Program. DCPA also enthusiastically supports this program and will hold a PPP match in conjunction with its 5-gun International Matches .

The PPP is an air pistol shoot for juniors. The air pistol must be of .177 caliber with open sights. The course of fire is 40 shots (plus sighters) at 10 meters.

Schedule is 9 a.m, 10:15 a.m., 11:30 a.m. and 12:45 pm. The cost is \$15 for non-DCPA Junior Members, \$10 for DCPA Junior members. DCPA has a small quantity of match quality air pistols available to competitors. Anyone wishing to use DCPA equipment must pre-register indicating same. Parents of Junior competitors who have their own equipment may elect to use their own equipment. Air pistols and pellets must conform to USA Shooting Rules and Specifications.

There are three categories of competitors and are defined by the shooting position used by the competitor. They are: **Basic Supported, Standing Supported** and **International (One-Handed) Standing**.

Basic Supported Maximum Age: 10.

Athlete may be seated or standing, 1 or 2 hands on the grip. The grip and hands may be rested on a firm support or a counterbalanced "sling" stand (T Stand), which DCPA will have available. If the T stand is used, the support point may be anywhere between elbow(s) and grip. The competitor's shooting arm should be fully extended, with the sights at eye level. The non-firing hand may provide support for the firing hand or the butt of the pistol. The shooter may rest any part of either or both hands and the butt of the pistol on the supporting material.

Standing Supported Maximum Age: 14

Athlete is standing, 1 hand on the grip. T Stand provides counterbalance support between elbow and grip. The competitor's shooting arm must be fully extended, with the sights at eye level.

International (One-Handed) Standing Maximum Age: 20, Minimum Age: 13.

International rules apply. Unsupported standing with one hand on the grip.

All juniors are encouraged to come out and give it a try.
